This letter is sent following receipt of our *No Further Action* letter from NJDEP. We are pleased with the speed and technical accuracy of your service, and now relieved that this is truly behind us.

As you know, we had an active oil tank and a time sensitive real estate transaction to preserve. Unfortunately, the tank had numerous holes, and most significantly, the soil type at the bottom of the tank was course sand. The oil passed to a depth of about 20'. ANCO was able to safely excavate to that depth in our urban setting following the installation of steel sheet shoring. The impacted soil was much deeper than our basement.

The next step was to prove that groundwater had not been affected. ANCO used their own Geoprobe and bored to over 26' at the point of greatest impact. The soil samples returned non detect, and no groundwater was observed.

We want to thank you for your service, personal attention, good advice and your patience with our concerns. As you know our consultant Merwin Kinkaid of Viridian Inc. was satisfied, and complimented your work.
